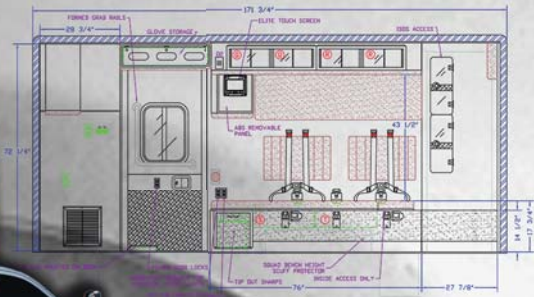
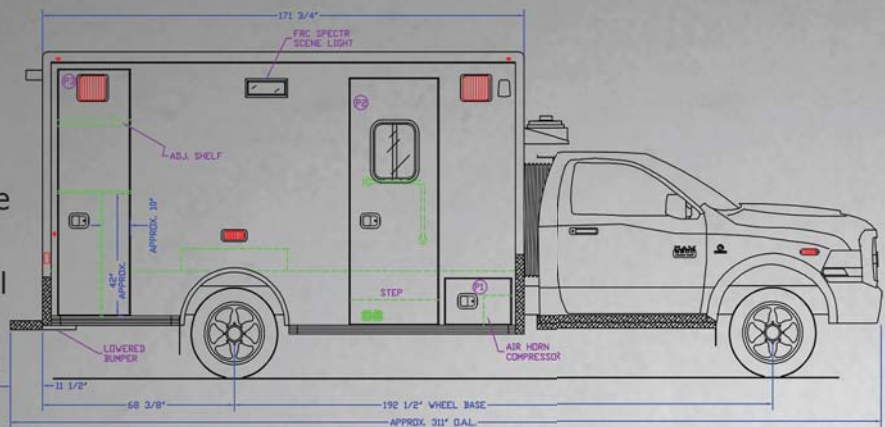

## WALLS

- ⊗ Solid, rectangular aluminum framing with 1/8" material thickness
- ⊗ Five horizontal aluminum tubes welded between verticals
- ⊗ Life Line proprietary "Triple Hollow" before & aft of the wheel well
- ⊗ "X-frame" Corner Extrusion

- ⊗ Double Walled 1/4" thickness 2" tube across the rear

## DOORS

- \* 3" Thick, Labyrinth style construction
- \* Enforcement Angled Gussets in all four corners of every door
- \* 3" Hinge with 1/4" pin, the widest hinge in the industry
- \* Door jamb extrusions fully welded around every door opening
